

With a double click on a title in the left selection window, this title is entered in the list selected on the right.

With the play button the entire list is played from the first track to the last track.

However, playback can be ended at any time with stop. Double-click on a title in the MP3 list to start playback with this title.

The volume of the playback can be changed with the slider - Volume +.

A function to clear all markings for a specific **SET** has been added. To do this, hold down the Ctrl key and left-click on the desired **SET** and confirm the following question with **YES**.

With the function key F5 on the PC keyboard (or a foot switch

programmed with F5), not only can you play an ink jet in the track selection mode, but now an mp3 file belonging to the track can be started when the score is displayed. The wireless PageFlip Dragon, which is connected to the PC via Bluetooth, is very suitable as a programmable foot switch. This is particularly interesting for accordion players who do not like to take their hands off the instrument to switch something.

1. When playing an MP3 belonging to the track, the volume can be adjusted directly on the monitor.





#### 2020-03-27
